•Attendance will be taken at the start of each class and students will either, need to be given permission by their parent or guardian to sign themself out, or be signed out by their guardian at the time of pick-up. Student should be dropped off and picked-up outside the back entrance to the main building (EHCC's rear parking lot), at which times they will be supervised by YAS/EHCC staff and/or volunteers. If a student is of legal driving age and will be responsible for their own transportation, parking will be available in the rear parking lot and students should enter through the back entrance. If the rear parking area is full, students will need to be responsible for finding parking on their own elsewhere. EHCC/YAS is not responsible for any loss or damages to vehicles parked off the property. Regardless of mode of transportation, if a student requires early release from the program on a certain day(s), please notify the YAS Coordinator. Students with an early release time are to be signed-out and picked up from the EHCC main office.
